CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. First named team is the home team and occupies 3rd base dugout and fields first.
2. Games shall be of 7 innings duration or until a result is achieved.
3. Ten run rule will apply after 5 innings.
4. Games will not commence earlier than noted in the official draw.
5. There will be a minimum of thirty (30) minutes between games.
6. After elimination round, teams will be split into two groups — top four teams to play in the championship round, bottom four teams to play in the consolation round. Where points are equal then placings are determined by the result of the games played between the tied teams in the qualifying round.
7. Allocation of points;

Championship round — The only points and percentages to carry over into the second round are those based on results of games played among teams qualified for the championship round.

Consolation round — All points and percentages are cumulative and carry into the second round.

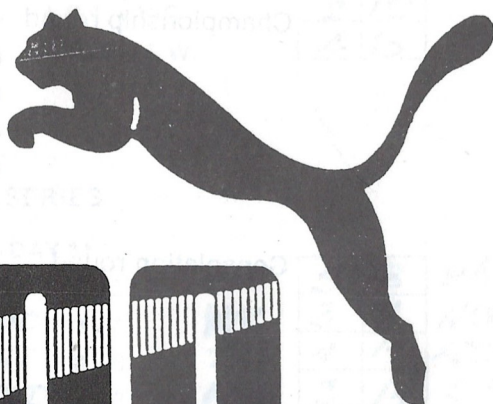
