

Calculation of Provisional Income Tax and Provisional Social Services Contribution in Respect of Income Year ending 30th June, 1947.

Provisional tax and provisional contribution are payable in respect of the income, other than salary or wages, of the year ending 30th June, 1947, and are calculated on the income, other than salary or wages, of the year ended 30th June, 1946. The amounts of such provisional tax and provisional contribution will be adjusted next year when the return of actual income of the year ending 30th June, 1947, is lodged and assessed.
