COMMENTS A very heavy gumlet - morrell paddock with unusual leamy - salmon gum sand seams about 4' deep where banks cross them. There is very little fall from east to west, salting which is in early stages is due, in my opinion, to numerous sand seams banking up against clay. Extreme difficulty in getting banks to main creek due to crab-holes & generally flat paddock, but 2 cm in 30 metres fall was generally achieved
