LETTERS PATENT, SEPTIMUS BURT AS ATTORNEY GENERAL

Whereas the Honorable Alfred Peach Hensman Esquire, Barrister at Law, Attorney General for the Colony of Western Australia has from this day been granted Leave of Absence and it is therefore necessary to make provision for the performance of the duties of the said office of Attorney General.

Now therefore I, Sir Frederick Napier Broome, Knight Commander of the most distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George Governor of the said Colony, do hereby appoint Septimus Burt Esquire, Barrister at Law, provisionally and subject to Her Majesty's pleasure to exercise and discharge all the powers and duties as such Attorney General, with the title of Acting Attorney General.
